What to Expect?

At 10:30 Sunday Club, there is one group.

At 4:30 Sunday Club, there are three groups: under 5s, 5-8s, 9-12s.

10:50	Split into groups for activities	4:50
11:20	Return to mats for prayer, the Lord's Prayer and a song	5:10
11:30	Go back to church for communion or final song	5:20
11:45	Church finishes	5:30

Sunday Club is designed for children at Primary School, before confirmation in year 6. If you have been confirmed, our hope is that you will feel able to worship in our church services, or perhaps occasionally serve as a young leader in one of our groups. We also have a Youth Group on a Thursday for anyone at Secondary School.
